



## **Notice of co-option to fill a Casual Vacancy in the Old Bolsover Central Ward**

A vacancy has arisen for the office of Councillor for Old Bolsover Town Council

Official notice was given of this vacancy on 5 November 2020 and no requests were received for an election to the Returning Officer of Bolsover District Council.

The Town Council will therefore proceed to fill the vacancies by co-option.

### **To stand for election on a parish council, you must:**

- be a UK or Commonwealth citizen; or
- be a citizen of the Republic of Ireland; or
- be a citizen of another Member state of the European Union; and
- be at least 18 years old.

### **To be eligible to stand for an election you must:**

- be an elector of the parish; or
- in the past 12 months have occupied (as owner or tenant) land or other premises in the parish; or
- work in the parish (as your principal or only place of work); or
- live within three miles of the parish boundary.

Interested parties should notify their intention to the Town Clerk by 12pm on Friday 8 January 2021 at the following address or by email.

Applicants will be invited to a virtual zoom meeting to introduce themselves to Councillors on Monday 11 January 2021 from 6.15pm prior to the decision at the Council meeting held on Tuesday 12 January 2021.

All candidates will be expected to put their request for consideration for co-option in writing using the application form which is available on the website or by contacting the office in person or by email.
