



Notice of co-option to fill a Casual Vacancy in the Old Bolsover with Stanfree Ward

A vacancy has arisen for the office of Councillor for Old Bolsover Town Council

Official notice was given of these vacancies on 9 July 2020 and no requests were received for an election to the Returning Officer of Bolsover District Council.

The Town Council will therefore proceed to fill the vacancies by co-option.

To stand for election on a parish council, you must:

- be a UK or Commonwealth citizen; or
- be a citizen of the Republic of Ireland; or
- be a citizen of another Member state of the European Union; and
- be at least 18 years old.

To be eligible to stand for an election you must:

- be an elector of the parish; or
- in the past 12 months have occupied (as owner or tenant) land or other premises in the parish; or
- work in the parish (as your principal or only place of work); or
- live within three miles of the parish boundary.

Interested parties should notify their intention to the Town Clerk by 12pm on Friday 9 October 2020 at the following address or by email.

All candidates will be expected to put their request for consideration for co-option in writing using the application form which is available on the website or by contacting the office in person or by email.
